

GENERAL SHOW RULES

Noosa Country Show is conducted under the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies and the rules of the Society and any regulation, which appears within the Schedule for individual sections of this Show.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

The Society engages the services of Security Personnel to assist with the provision of care of all exhibits, livestock, and property, and whilst the Society takes all reasonable care, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for any loss or damage to or by any exhibits, livestock, equipment, vehicles, or any other property.

PRIZE MONEY

- Equestrian collect at equestrian office.
- Pavilion, Art, Photography, Poultry, Guinea Pig, Wood Chop, Junior and Stud Beef – issued by Steward at end of competition or collection of exhibits.

SHOW ADMISSION

General admission

- Tickets to the Noosa Country Show may be purchased on-line or at the Gate.
- All persons, except members and volunteers, shall pay admittance to the Show unless otherwise provided with a pass by the Committee.
- The Society reserves the right to check bags, jackets, prams and cars on entry to the show or entering bar areas.
- No alcohol permitted to be brought into the Showgrounds.
- Exhibitors and persons admitted to the grounds shall be subject to these rules as well as the Rules of the Society.

Competitors Pass

 Only available to Equestrian, Young Judges and Handlers, and Stud Beef Entrants and is to be purchased online at time of class nomination, and confirmation email is to be presented at the gate.

COMPETITION/EXHIBITS

- Check individual sections for the entries closure dates.
- Payment of your class/s is mandatory with your nominations.
- Entries not accepted unless payment is complete.
- Entry fee/s and prize money stated in individual schedules.
- The Society reserves the right to amend the classes of competition at any time prior to the commencement of Judging.
- No exhibitors allowed in the Pavilion or Squash Courts during Judging.
- Stewards reserve the right to declare a noncompetition in any class where insufficient exhibits presented into a class, therefore combined classes may occur. All exhibits judged.
- Exhibits not accepted if previously won "First Prize" at any Noosa Country Show in either Creative Craft, Junior section, Photography or Art. However, the Steward may display exhibit if room available.
- Photography exhibits not judged if not in accordance with the printing requirements.
- The Society reserves the right to refuse admittance to any exhibit where there is reason to suspect either disease or danger or inappropriate and may remove any such exhibit from the show.
- Where any conflict may arise between the General Rules listed in this document and the sections' Condition of Entry, the sections Condition of Entry will prevail.
- The Judge/s decision is final.

NOMINATE – online nominations:

- Equestrian Events Friday and Saturday enter classes through Nominate Equestrian link on NSS website.
- Art, Photography, Guinea Pigs, Poultry, Young Judges and Handlers, and Stud Beef Sections enter classes through Nominate link on NSS website.
